## Arielle Update

I received this update on little Arielle. She was diagnosed with a very rare form of leukemia. She needed a bone marrow transplant. That has taken place. Arielle is now home from the hospital.

The following was sent to me by Cardiac Cowboy:

The doctors in Boston Children's Hosp were amazed at how well she was doing. Usually after a bone marrow transplant they have to stay in Boston for a few weeks and seen in the clinic 3 x a week, and if improvement it goes to 2 a week then 1 then home. But in Arielle's case her lab work showed how well she was doing and she was able to go home a lot sooner. She will still have to be seen by a oncologist at Albany for lab work. She has an nj tube in place because her bicarb level was low and she has to take 5 cc's 3 times a day and that stuff would gag a horse. So her parents just give it through the tube and when her levels are up the tube will be removed. It's amazing all that has to be done to make her home safe prior to coming home. The entire house had to be cleaned top to bottom and sterilized. No one will be able to visit for approx. 6 mos. I long to hold her once again. It shows the power of prayer and God's blessing.

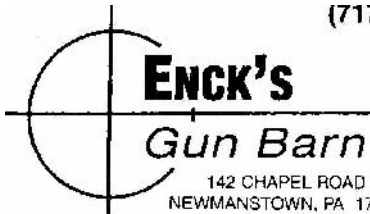
