Answer to Last Month's "What's The Call"

The Correct answer is: (C) Miss + Minor Safety + 4 Bonuses

- Applicable Rules:

One Miss for the actual miss on R/P-5 with first pistol
One Minor Safety for retrieving a dropped round.
Four bonuses for hits on R/P-1>4 from position "C"

Applicable rules:

24. Ammunition dropped by a shooter in the course of reloading any firearm during a stage or "ejected" from any firearm is considered "dead" and may not be recovered until the shooter completes the course of fire. The round must be replaced from the shooter's person or other area as required by stage description or if the round is not fired it is counted as a missed shot.

Staged ammunition dropped back where it was staged is not considered "dead".

Shooters Handbook (page 23)

24. Ammunition dropped by a shooter in the course of loading or reloading any firearm during a stage or "ejected" is considered "dead" and may not be recovered until the shooter completes the course of fire. The round must be replaced from the shooter's person or other area as required by stage description, or if the round is not fired, it is counted as a missed shot.

For example, if a round of shotgun ammo is dropped while loading; the round must be replaced from the shooter's person or other area as required by stage description or counted as a miss.

No attempt may be made by the shooter, or any other person, to pick up the dropped round for use on that stage. Trying to recover a dropped round prompts loss of muzzle direction control. Once the dropped round leaves the shooter's hand or control, it is considered to be a dead round. Stop the shooter if he tries to recover the dead round. It is a 10-second Minor Safety Violation if the shooter during or after the stage retrieves the round.

Range Ops (page 17)

NOTE: The question of whether loading and firing the "dead" round is also MISS has been ruled a "NO CALL". Any targets hit using a round that has been retrieved after being dropped/ejected count as HITS.

What's The Call

Answer next month

Pistols - 5 rounds each - holstered
Rifle - 10 rounds (staged at "B")
Shotgun - 4+ rounds.

****Shooter is registered in the "Duelist Category" shooting "Double Duelist" style****

Scenario:

Shooter starts at "A" with unloaded shotgun in both hands (no ammo in hand).

At the beep, engage S1 - S4 in any order until all targets are down.

Move to "B" and engage R1 - R5 with two rounds each.

Move to "C" and engage P1 - P5 with two rounds each.

At the beep, Shooter engages shotgun and rifle targets correctly with no misses.

Shooter moves to "C", draws first pistol and "double taps" P1, P1, P2, P2 then holsters first pistol.

Draws 2nd pistol and cocks it, but before firing it, realizes that there is one more round to be fired in the 1st pistol.

Shooter re-draws first pistol, while 2nd pistol remains "Out" and "Cocked", and fires the remaining round from 1st pistol on P3 in a "Double Duelist" style. Shooter then fires 2nd pistol on P3, P4, P4, P5, P5.
