PP - Pocket Pistol - One stage allows you to use your pocket pistol or the club supplied pistol

## What's the Call Answer

Question: I know I cannot de-cock on the firing line with live rounds in my pistol, but what about if all rounds have been fired? On more than a couple occasions I have fired all five rounds but apparently either lost count or in my exuberance just cock the gun again. The TO says "That's all" seeing me do this, so I de-cock and holster, not pull the trigger. The way I read the rule in black and white I may be committing an error worthy of a SDQ, however I have never been given one or even had the action mentioned by anyone. Perhaps the TO(s) knows I'm de-cocking for that reason and it is considered under their supervision, I don't know. If this is a SDQ obviously this is a habit I need to break.

Answer from Pale Wolf Brunelle ... The rule is quite clear and straightforward.

Shooter MUST either "dry fire" or decock (under T/O supervision...which is further clarified in the rule itself) in order to avoid the SDQ for the cocked revolver leaving the shooter's hand (loaded or not).

Follow up question ... "I had to ask permission last weekend,(first gun on the stage) pulled both pistols (gunfighter), the first one failed to fire,the second was cocked, I stopped, looked over my shoulder and asked TO for permission to decock"

Answer from Pale Wolf Brunelle .... If you mean the GUNFIGHTER-style scenario...yes...the hammer would be decocked on a live round (while being pointed SAFELY downrange). At that point, the shooter and T/O both know the condition of the revolvers (or SHOULD) and both can be SAFELY reindexed to "empty under hammer" for a RESTART...or to SAFELY move off the stage to ascertain why the first revolver failed to fire.

More questions ... What I have seen is the more common situation where the shooter clocks a revolver after firing five shots. I still think it is preferable to direct the shooter to point the gun downrange and pull the trigger.

More answers from Pale Wolf Brunelle .... In that case, the TO simply saying "Drop that hammer" would cover all bases while "safely assisting" the shooter to avoid the penalty. That would also give the shooter a choice to "legally" do so either way ...without any chance of an appeal based on T/O "interference" for telling the shooter to do one thing, when another action would be acceptable.

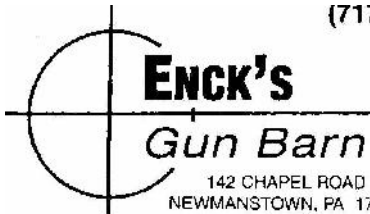
