The main match registration money went to the Arielle Leukemia fund. Gunpeddler donated a Walther pellet rifle which we raffled off and that money also went to the leukemia fund. We received 2 donations from Cowboys who were unable to attend the match. Thanks to the generosity of the great Cowboys and Cowgirls, we were able to raise a total of \$497.00 for the Arielle Leukemia fund. In addition, we collected \$175.00 and 46 food items for the Perry County Food Bank. Navajo Ned won the pellet rifle.

Arielle Update

I received this update on little Arielle. She was diagnosed with a very rare form of leukemia. She has had a bone marrow transplant.

The following was sent to me by her father, Jason Rudasill:

"I want to thank you and the Cowboys for raising money for Arielle! This donation will certainly go a long way in supporting us during this time. Arielle is doing great at this time. The latest high resolution DNA exam reported there was ZERO evidence of the genetic mutation that caused the Leukemia in the first place. This means the transplant was hugely successful! Recently she had some arterial lung damage and pulmonary hypertension which was caused by the procedure to treat the cancer, so she is currently on Oxygen and has also recovered from that. She really is doing great. Please express our gratitude to them. Thank you for making a difference in our lives, God Bless you all."

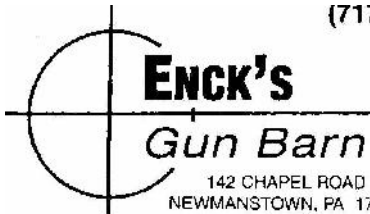
