## Answer to Last Month's "What's The Call"

The Correct answer is: (B) Procedural

The Correct Reasoning is:

### 10-Second Penalties

Failure to adhere to the guidelines of the category in which you are competing.  
SASS Range Operations Basic Safety Course Version G (page 18)

### DUELIST

Revolvers may be shot one in one hand and one in the other, but at no time shall the competitor have two loaded revolvers in hand at once.  
SASS Shooters Handbook March 2006 Twelfth Edition (page 30)

The Gunfighter and B-Western Categories are the only categories that allow two loaded revolvers out of leather at the same time.  
SASS Shooters Handbook March 2006 Twelfth Edition (page 31/49)

8. Once a revolver is cocked, the round under the hammer must be expended in order for it to be returned to a safe condition...  
9. If a firearm is shot out of sequence or from the wrong position, the shooter will be awarded a single procedural penalty. ...

Additional Comments:

Since the stage description did not specify that the revolvers be shot "1<sup>st</sup> pistol/2<sup>nd</sup> pistol", the shooter could have:

A) Fired the first round from the second pistol, then re-holstered that revolver before re-drawing the first pistol to fire the fifth round, or  
B) Fired the 2<sup>nd</sup> pistol on P3, P3, P4, P4, P5; then re-draw the 1<sup>st</sup> pistol for the last shot on P5, with NO Penalty for firing the guns "out of order".

## What's The Call

Answer next month

Pistol: 5 rounds each, holstered (+1 round reload)

Rifle: 9 rounds

Shotgun: 4+

Shooter is registered in Gunfighter category using a SxS shotgun with Black Powder loads in all firearms.

Stage description: Sweep P1 > P5 from left to right with first pistol. Repeat with second pistol. Reload one round (at any time) and engage P3 with the last shot.

Move to rifle: Engage rifle targets in a Nevada sweep, starting on left target. R1, R2, R3, R4.

Shotgun: Sweep knock down targets. S1, S2, S3, S4 starting on either end.

At the beep, shooter draws one pistol; loads the empty chamber; then draws the second pistol and engages the pistol targets in the following manner:

Alternating pistols: P1, P1, P2, P2, P3, P3, P4, P4, P5, P5. All fired rounds are Hits. Holsters pistols.

Shooter moves to rifle. Engages rifle targets in the following order starting on left target. R1, R2, R3, R4, R3, R2, R1, R2, R3. Hits on all targets. Lays rifle down, lever open.

Shooter moves to shotgun. Engages targets in the following order: S1, S2 (miss), S3, S4, S2

Before the shooter leaves the firing line, the RO checks the first pistol and determines that there is an unfired round in the first revolver, but that it is NOT under the hammer.

At the unloading table, an unfired round is found on the carrier of the rifle.

- C. Miss + Two Minor Safeties + Procedural
- D. Two Minor Safeties + Procedural + Failure to Engage

## Work Days

This year the Perry County Veterans' Transportation will be the recipient of the main match proceeds. Also, as we have done in previous years, you can receive a Dag-Nab-It good for a 5 second bonus for each 5 food items or \$5.00 cash you donate to the Perry County Food Bank. There is no limit on the number of Dag-Nab-Its you can get. However, these cannot be used to have a "clean match".. Also this year we will sell honorary "clean matches" for \$50.00 and honorary "match winners" for \$100.00. Shooters who buy these would receive a certificate recognizing their donation. These would not affect the true outcome of the match and would be recognized separately from the true match winners and true clean shooters. No "clean match pins" or free shoots would be given for the "honorary clean match shooters. All proceeds of the honorary awards will go to the Perry County Food Bank.


