Work Days

Work days will be March 22 and March 29 at 8:00 AM. We will be getting ready for the new shooting season. Here is what is currently planned for those days.

a. Reset targets and level. All the targets were taken down last fall and need to be put back into place. We will have wood to level the targets. On bay 2, the teeter-totter will be moved to the center of the stage. We will be resetting the track for the mover.

b. Move tables. The loading and unloading tables were put under cover for the winter. These need to be moved back to the bays. We will have a trailer or two to load them onto for the move.

c. General cleanup. This winter has been a hard one. We will have to pick up any limbs that may have come down. We need to get ready for mowing, so any other rocks or debris will have to be picked up.

d. Even outhouse with shooting table (bay 6)

e. Extend the roof over the shooting table on Bay one. We have the materials to do it. Butch McCandles will lead a team to do this. We will need a couple of folks with hammers to help.

f. Drill holes in the floor of the fort to drain water that stands on the floor. We will need one or two cordless drills to do this.

Once the targets are set, we will check them - Need pistol and rifle with ammo. "Dead" targets will be replaced. There is plenty of steel in the shed.

Letort Lawman estimated that we will need approximately 15 people to perform all these tasks.

In addition to the tools listed above, we recommend that you bring work gloves to handle the steel targets. Depending on the weather, you may also need boots (may be muddy). We will also need a couple shovels.

Breakfast

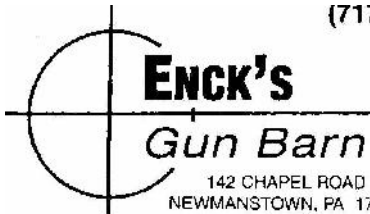
