However, these cannot be used to have a "clean match". Also this year we will sell honorary "clean matches" for \$50.00 and honorary "match winners" for \$100.00. Shooters who buy these would receive a certificate recognizing their donation. These would not affect the true outcome of the match and would be recognized separately from the true match winners and true clean shooters. No "clean match pins" or free shoots would be given for the "honorary clean match shooters. All proceeds of the honorary awards will go to the Perry County Food Bank.

Safety Practices (page 37)

6. Six-guns are always loaded with only five rounds and the hammer lowered and left resting on the empty chamber. Five shooters may load five rounds, but the hammer must rest on a dummy chamber or safety slot in the cylinder so the hammer does not rest on a live round/cap.

Safety Practices (page 41)

18. When changing location during a stage, all firearms being carried must either have the hammer down on an empty chamber or spent case, or have the action open.

SASS Range Operations Basic Safety Course Version F
Appendix A - Range Rules (page 11)

4. Six-guns are ALWAYS loaded with only five rounds and the hammer lowered and resting on the empty chamber. Five shooters may load five rounds, but the hammer must rest on a dummy chamber or safety slot in the cylinder so the hammer does not rest on a live round/cap. All guns are loaded based upon stage requirements.

Loading more than the correct number of rounds in long guns will result in the assessment of a 10-second Minor Safety Penalty.

Failure to adhere to loading and unloading procedures will result in a Stage Disqualification.

Stage Disqualification (page 18)

• Changing location with a cocked gun or a gun with the hammer down on a live round.

-

• Holstering or staging a pistol with the hammer down on a live round

-

Pocket RO Card (page 27)

Holstering or staging gun with hammer cocked (not fully down) or down (on a live round) = SDQ

Changing location with a cocked gun/gun w/hammer down on live round = SDQ

The Stage Disqualification makes any other safety penalties and/or misses moot.

Firearm sequence: Rifle - 9 / Pistol - 5 / Pistol - 5 / Shotgun - 4+

Shooter:

Engages rifle targets, sets rifle down open and empty.

Draws first pistol and engages targets with the following results:

Bang, Bang, Bang, CLICK, Bang, click, click, click, click, click.

Opens loading gate, loads an additional round in the empty chamber and engages the last pistol target with the reloaded round. Holsters pistol and finishes the stage.

The following is an update on some of the agenda items to be discussed at the SASS TG Convention this December. Please feel free to contact me if you would like me to expand on any of these items.

Logos on apparel clarification: SASS will continue the educational process on this issue, through articles in the Cowboy Chronicle, to encourage compliance with the ruling on same.

Classic Cowboy category clarification: a screw knife does NOT fulfill the requirement for knife.

B-Western category clarification: Rule states "Western spurs with ROWELS." Cavalry - style spurs do NOT comply with that requirement.

SASS Regulator process will be re-visited.

Regional Chief RO's will be added to the review processes.

Accidental Discharge in the unloading area when clearing a declared malfunctioning firearm.

Open or Closed Action will be added as an agenda discussion item. Noted that it is the ACTION, not the LEVER that must be "open" = NOT CLOSED.
